Cooking July 7 - 12

LIT (Leaders In Training)

Offered Weeks 2 – 6

Ages 15 - 18 \$700 for 5 weeks

Leadership calls for a combination of skills, which require a great deal of practice. Our 5 week overnight training program is designed to develop foundational leadership skills, such as communication, teamwork and problem-solving, through discussion, play and practice.

You must participate in all 5 weeks to successfully complete the program and you must complete this program to participate in SIT. An application is required for acceptance into this program.
